We are now accepting submissions for GDevCon ANZ Presentations. Have you considered presenting your work or lessons learned to the LabVIEW community? Read on!


- 1. There are two options a full 45-minute presentation, or a short 7-minute presentation. Full presenters get a free ticket to the conference.
